UISPP IN PARIS

Prehistoric research, in the dawn of the third millennium, faces contradictory challenges. While scientific advances and technological resources allow for new analytical procedures, with relevant new knowledge being produced and conveyed, institutional and financial resources for research are growingly put into question, and in several countries contextual instability prevents any field or laboratory research to pursue. In this context, scholars face the need to strengthen their research networks across countries and continents, attempting that no constraints, beyond the needs of research, condition their participation in investigation programmes, meetings or congresses.

In this context, UISPP has reinforced a web of research networks, through its **30 scientific commissions**, organized in the **five continents** in **seven main areas**: Historiography, Methods and Theories; Technology and Economy; Specific Environments; Culture and Economy; Art and Culture; and Archaeology and societies. These commissions are responsible for a large dimension of current world research, and constitute the core of UISPP.

UISPP will organize its **XVIII world congress, from the 4th to the 9th June 2018, in Paris.**

UISPP AWARDS

Six awards will be attributed within the XVIII world congress:

- Award of the **best young researcher** (prehistory award and protohistory award): Free registration to UISPP congress during ten years + publication on line on the UISPP site of two original manuscripts + member in a UISPP scientific committee
- Gold Medal of the **senior researcher** (5 medals): UISPP Certificate + UISPP honorary member.

REGISTRATION FEES

Full price: 300 € before 31-10-2017 and 350 € after. The price includes the UISPP membership fee for three years (75 €).

Reduced price: 135 € before 31-10-2017 and 160 € after. The price includes the reduced membership fee for three years (30 €). The reduced price is applicable only for students, PhD students and unemployed

Payment by credit card can be performed directly on the Web site. The UISPP membership fees are mandatory for all the participants (2018-2020 for those who have already paid 2015-2017; 2015-2018 for the others).

Within the registration fees the following services are included: coffee morning and afternoon; lunch; conference bag with badge and USB key; abstracts (pdf); congress agenda (pdf); free admission to museum; online publishing acts of the congress.

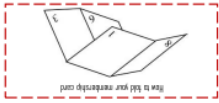
The social events, the post congress excursions and publications on French Prehistory are not included in the registration fees.
